

Based on the Bologna Declaration and Salzburg Principles and Article 94, paragraph 22 of the Law on Higher Education, (Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia, no. 82/2018) and Article 31 paragraph 20 and Article 65 of the South East European University Statute, the University Senate at its meeting held on 25.02.2020 approved the following:

RULE ON AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE RULE ON THIRD CYCLE ACADEMIC STUDIES – DOCTORAL STUDIES

Article 1

Article 16, paragraph 2, is amended as follows:

“The mentor cannot have more than 3 (three) candidates/PhD’s for doctoral studies simultaneously, counted from the date of the approval of the dissertation title and the mentor in the Teaching-Scientific Council, until the submission of the final report by the mentor to the Faculty Teaching-Scientific Council”.

Article 2

Article 21, paragraph 1, is amended as follows:

“The student should fulfil these basic criteria for enrolment in the third cycle of studies:

1. To have completed the first and second cycle of studies;
2. To have accumulated 300 ECTS from both study cycles;
3. To have an active knowledge of the English language;
4. To meet other criteria defined by the Law on Higher Education, the Statute of the University, the Rule for Student Enrolment and the Call for Student Enrolment.”

Article 3

Article 29, paragraph 1, is amended as follows:

“A student who has completed the first year lectures and has maximum two exams left out of all exams foreseen in the study programme may submit a draft doctoral proposal at the Faculty Teaching-Scientific Council. This includes a one page text in which the draft research proposal is described and power point presentation.”

Article 4

The University Secretariat is authorized to prepare consolidated text of the Rule on Third Cycle Studies – Doctoral Studies.

Article 5

This Rule enters into force on the day of its adoption.
